




GENERAL ORDER

The Court having received the Supreme Court Order 2020-39 regarding Kentucky Court of Justice response to COVID-19 Emergency - Health and Safety Requirements for the Expansion of Court Operations, the Court being fully and sufficiently advised;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all Civil Motions filed for Floyd Circuit Court, Division I and Division II shall be noticed for a regularly scheduled Motion Hour. On the date that the Motion is noticed for no parties shall appear. The Court shall review said Motions and any Motions requiring a hearing shall be issued a hearing date via Order. Any Motions for Default Judgment shall be filed with proof of service attached and all Motions shall have proposed Orders attached. All hearings shall be conducted via Zoom or telephonically unless the Court determines that appearances are necessary. In the event that the Judge determines appearances to be required only the parties and attorneys shall be permitted into the Courtroom. Any necessary witnesses are asked to remain in their car and will be notified via cell phone when they are needed in the Courtroom. All parties entering the Floyd County Justice Center shall be required to wear a mask. No purses, bags or brief cases of any kind will be permitted into the building. Parties will be allowed in no earlier than Five (5) minutes prior to the scheduled start time of their hearing.
